16.	The Objectives of the assignment	The main purpose of the assignment is to upgrade/modify/add our ongoing web-based Loan Management (Microfinance) System in a timely manner. With this software, 3200 villages of our current Resilience, Entrepreneurship and Livelihood Improvement (RELI) project and 2500 villages of the previous NJLIP, a total of 5700 villages will be to automate and monitor the community finance activities (Loan Management). This system will be a robust system in terms of handling very large number of user (about 7000), to handle around 12.0 Lac loan account and huge volume of data and transactions. This system should provide suitable flexible interactive user-friendly tools to allow collation of inputs from various village institutions (i.e. Gram Somiti (GS) and Village Credit Organization (VCO)), produce standard reports; term based and drill down reports, and disseminate information to policymakers and stakeholders in a systematic way. The detailed scopes of the work are specified in Scope of Work Section.
17.	Qualification & Experiences	The Social Development Foundation now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are: General experience of the Firm(s); Experience of similar tasks such as experience as a software development firm with experience of designing, developing, maintaining computerized web based Microcredit System that is being used by at least 2(two) organizations from at least 20 different office locations, Financial soundness, staffing and logistics of the firm. Availability of appropriate skills among staff: The agency/firm must have appropriate professional and technical team with high level of competencies to handle tasks and responsibilities. Evidence of engagement of software development professionals should be in the regular payroll of the concerned firm and Support service of the consultants (firm). Consultants are requested to submit the following supporting documents in support of the above-mentioned criteria: (i) Up to date relevant registration papers of the firm (s); (ii) JV agreement/letter of intent (if applicable); (iii) Firm's brochure; (iv) Audited financial reports for last three years; (v) Service experience record of Last five (05) years (including nature, total cost of Contract, total input in terms of man month, employer, location of service etc.); (vi) Updated trade license; (vii) Turnover of the consulting firm; (viii) any other information necessary to substantiate the short-listing criteria listed above and/or included in the TOR; However, Key Experts will not be evaluated at the short-listing stage;
